Membership in the Nova Scotia Colony of Mayflower Descendants Society

- a. Regular Members of the Nova Scotia Colony of Mayflower Descendants Society must also be members of the Canadian Society of Mayflower Descendants.
- b. Associate members may vote and attend meetings and are those people who are interested in the objectives of the Society, but who are not members of the Canadian Society of Mayflower Descendants . Associate members will, by paying dues to the Nova Scotia Colony of Mayflower Descendants Society, become members of the Nova Scotia Colony of Mayflower Descendants Society, but are not listed as members of the Canadian Society of Mayflower Descendants until certified by that Society.
- c. A member in good standing in the Nova Scotia Colony of Mayflower Descendants Society may make application for Junior Membership for any person under age 18 who has a proven lineage by blood through the same line used by the approved sponsoring member. The application may be approved and accepted by the Canadian Junior Membership Committee upon completion and acceptance of the form and the required fee. Junior members may attend meetings, but may not vote or hold office.
